b. Professional Development

Many professional development opportunities are now available online via CalPro and O-TAN and/or CASAS for Adult Education professionals. The CASAS Summer Institute

- d. Governor's Budget – CAEP P. Mendez
1.6% COLA for Adult Education programs. Discussion ensued about the governor's proposed budget. It was recommended that individual schools write a letter to the governor.

P. Mendez will be meeting with S. Morales from Mayaco concerning the upcoming contract for the maintenance of the website. Consortium members expressed concern regarding responsiveness to updated website. It was also requested that a website metric report be requested from Mayaco and discussed at the March 1 meeting.
- f. Pandemic Member Check-In All
Members shared and discussed what is working and what is not working during the pandemic. Programs like ESL and High School Diploma programs are struggling. However, some short term CTE programs have done well – ICT and Health. However, generally CTE classes are designed for smaller numbers. It was also noted some families have not returned from countries like Mexico. There was a discussion around devices. Several school sites provide loan devices for students as a strategy to provide them with home capacity to enroll in virtual classes.
- g. Connections: Grants, WIOA, Cares, etc. All
It was requested that this item remain on the agenda. Discussion ensued about different priorities and collaboration. Turlock shared they applied for a recent IET (Integrated English Training) opportunity for their ESL to Certified Nursing Assistant program. Modesto JC also joined an effort lead by Merced County WIOA in partnership with Stanislaus County Workforce Development.

Action: P Mendez, D Plaa and L Alaniz to look at resource opportunities for the consortium pursue for adult education programs. Late Spring 2021 meeting.
