7. Take ANTHRO 102.
8. Take ANTHRO 130.
9. Take COMM 100 or 102.

13. Pick one course from the General Education Options - CSU GE: D/ IGETC: 4 /Group a.
14. Pick and Anthropology AAT selection of any remaining course from List A or any course from List B. If you have taken PHILO 107 you can also choose from List C.¹
15. Pick a course from the Anthropology List C table.²
16. Pick one course from the General Education Options - CSU GE: D/ IGETC: 4 /Group b.
17. If you did not take COLSK 100 and might transfer to a CSU take HE 110 or PSYCH 110. If you did take it skip this step.
18. If you took an IGETC 6A requirement then take a third CSU GE: C / IGETC 3 course or if you have not yet reached 60 units pick and elective. If you have not taken at least two years of foreign language in high school, and have not taken an IGETC 6A, but might transfer to a UC take a language course.
19. If you have not yet reached 60 units take an elective course numbered between 100-299.
