

ART AA Coursework Roadmap

This degree is primarily intended for students who intend to transfer to a private or out of state institution. It can also be used to as a stand-alone, two-year degree. Students intending to transfer to a UC or CSU should use the Studio Arts AAT or Art History AATs. See a counselor to determine whether to use MJC or CSU GE for your intended transfer destination(s).

Instructions:

Be sure to work with a counselor to make sure that your choices work for all of your intended transfer institutions.

1. Take COLSK 100 & GUIDE 111 or GUIDE 110.
2. Take Art 120.
3. Take Art 164 or Art 165.
4. Take ENGL 100 or 101.
5. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options – MJC GE Area B / CSU GE: D.
6. Take Art 124.
7. Pick a course from one of the five areas in the Art AA Elective table.
8. Take COMM 100 or 102.
9. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options – CSU GE: A3 or take any elective numbered 100-299 if you do not intend to transfer.
10. Take MATH 101 (may need MATH 32) or Math 89**.
