Instructions:

Be sure to work with a counselor to make sure that your choices work for all of your intended transfer institutions.

1. Take COLSK 100 & GUIDE 111¹.
2. Pick your 1st selection from the Humanities Core table.
3. Pick a course from the Humanities Group 3 elective table.
4. Take ENGL 100 or 101.
5. Take COMM 100 or 102.
6. Pick your 2nd selection from the Humanities Core table.
7. Take ENGL 103, PHILO 105 or READ 184².
8. Take MATH 101 (may need MATH 32) or MATH 105³.
9. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 1.
10. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 2, Group a.

¹ Or take any CSU GE: Area E offering if you might transfer to a CSU.

² READ 184 does not meet the IGETC 1B requirement and should not be selected if you might transfer to a UC.

11. Pick your 1st selection from the Humanities Core table.
12. Pick a course from the Humanities Group 1 elective table.
13. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B / IGETC 5.
14. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 2, Group b.
15. Take any ART, CMPGR, COMM, DANCE, MUSA, MUSC, MUSE, MUST or THETR course(s) from the Activities list for at least 2 units.
16. If you have not taken at least two years of foreign language in high school, and you might transfer to a UC, pick a course from the IGETC 6A table. If you have already met this requirement then skip this step.
17. Pick a course from the Humanities Group 2 elective table.
18. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B / IGETC 5 from the area you did not choose in step 13.
19. If you did not take COLSK 100 take a CSU GE: Area E offering, or take an elective numbered between 100-299.²
20. If you have not reached 60 transferable take an elective numbered between 100-299. Continue to take electives until you reach 60 units.
