4. Take COMM 100 or 102.¹
5. Pick a course from the AA Languages List.
6. Take ENGL 103.
7. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4.²
8. Take MATH 101 (may need MATH 32) or MATH 105 & MATH 106.³
9. Take a course from the MJC Activities Requirement List.

13. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: C1 / IGETC 3A.
14. Pick a 4th course from the Languages AA List if you have not yet reached complete 14 units from this table. If you have completed 14 units move to the next step.
15. Pick a course from the AA Electives List.
16. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Group a table.
17. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B1 or B2 / IGETC: 5A or 5B. If you did not complete the laboratory requirement in step 12 choose a course with a lab.
18. Take another MJC Activity course if the course you took in step 18 did not meet the two-unit requirement.
19. Check with a counselor to make sure you have completed your CSU GE Area E requirements if you are transferring to a CSU and/or your IGETC 3B requirements if you are transferring to a UC. If you have not reached 60 transferable units take an additional course from the AAT Languages or Electives tables, or choose an elective numbered between 100-299.
