7. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: A3 / IGETC 1B.
8. Take MATH 101 (may need MATH 32) or MATH 105.¹
9. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: C2 / IGETC 3B.
10. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 1.

14. Pick one course from List B electives table.

15. If you did not take COLSK 100 pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: E Table. If you took COLSK 100 skip this step.

16. Pick one course from List C electives table.

17. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B / IGETC 5 from the area you did not choose in step 11. **If you did not complete the laboratory requirement in step 11 choose a course with a lab.**

18. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 3.

19. For UC transfer take one additional US Constitutions requirement course. For CSU transfer take an additional List C elective or take any elective between 100-299.

20. If you have not taken at least two years of foreign language in high school and plan to transfer to a UC take an IGETC: Area 6A language course, or if you have not reached 60 transferable units choose an additional List C elective, or take an elective numbered between 100-299.
