6. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: C1 / IGETC 3A Table.
7. Take PHILO 120 or 121.
8. Take ENGL 102.
9. Take PHILO 111 or pick a course that meets the Philosophy AAT List B requirement. Check the Philosophy Transfer Course Guide for your transfer institution(s).
10. Take MATH 101 (may need MATH 32), MATH 130, MATH 134(may need MATH 34 & 135), or PSYCH 121^{2,3}

15. Pick a course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B2 / IGETC 5B. If you did not complete the laboratory requirement in step 13 choose a course with a lab.
16. Take PHILO 107 or 130 if you might transfer to a UC or pick a CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 course, or take any elective numbered between 100-299.
17. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Table 2, Group b.
18. Pick a Philosophy Transfer course, or pick one course from the Suggested Electives list or pick an elective numbers 100-299.
19. If you have not taken at least two years of foreign language in high school then take FREN 101 or GERM 101 if you might transfer to a UC, or pick an elective numbers 100-299.
