18. Pick a pick from course from the AAT List A electives table.
19. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: B / IGETC 5. If you did not complete the laboratory requirement in step 15 choose a course with a lab.
20. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Group a.
21. Pick one course from the list of General Education Options - CSU GE: D / IGETC 4 Group b.
22. Take THETR 133/134/135/136, 190 or THETR 196.¹
23. Take THETR Elective as needed to meet degree requirements. Students transferring to UC and have not taken at least two years of foreign language in high school should take a language course that meets the IGETC: Area 6A.
