2. LFM Data Team Presentation

The latest Data Liaison Proposal presentation was shared. A discussion ensued on the roles of the data liaison and implementation metrics. It was noted that the liaisons may need to meet monthly with the Office of Institutional Effectiveness to check in to see if the data collected is sufficient, or if more or different data needs to be collected, as each School's data collection will be different. Suggestions were made to include success data on ELIC (English Language Instruction for College) students and to possibly have the data liaison team and online education person report out regularly to the Guided Pathways Steering Committee and PIT Crew. The group was reminded that it takes at least a year to get something meaningful out of the collected data.

The LFM team will now hand the proposal off to the PIT Crew for review. They will not meet again, but will be available to answer any questions.

3. Scale of Adoption Assessment (SOAA) Update

The SOAA had a second reading by College Council on Monday, February 22, with four minor edits. The report will now be entered in NOVA in order to make the March 1 deadline. PIT Crew members were thanked for their contributions to the document.
