1. **Guided Pathways Classified Training**

A document draft furnished by our regional coordinators entitled, The College Professional Guided Pathways Series, was reviewed. The first in the series, Classified Professionals: My Role in the Big Picture, will be presented by Central Valley Mother Lode (CVML) Regional Coordinator Ricardo Marmolejo and is tentatively scheduled for June 10, 2021.

2. **GUIDED PATHWAYS PRIMARY SCHOOL EMAIL**

Faculty members with programs in two Schools were sent an email asking which School office they consider their home office (scheduling, supplies, etc.) and which School Success Network they recommend support their students. Answers are forthcoming.

3. **Data Summit**

The type of data to collect for the summit and the measurement of success was discussed at length. Academic Senate Resolution F19-C: Additional Student Data Metrics for Program Review was discussed and it was determined the data remains to be collected.

4. **Summer-Fall Communication Plan**

a. **Logic Model Part 1**

Members used a logic model to participate in a brainstorming activity to determine problems and desired outcomes. Their results are as follows:

**Problem Statements**

- Avoid non-unified message - Presenting a unified message
- We haven't created a liaison team for the schools
- How much are we communicating with schools and how are we doing this?
- We only speak through the LFM group (orientation)
- Division-school organization
- **What fundamentally will be changed (administratively, faculty, classified staff, students) with Guided Pathways?**  
Contextualized curriculum will probably be a change for schools and faculty
- Curricular program review and scheduling
- What is the unified message we want to communicate?
- I think if we had a Goal/Message and Purpose sent out to the campus for each School – this would answer a lot of “unknowns” people are questioning.
- Condensed version of the SOAA

This activity will be revisited at the next PIT Crew meeting. Information gathered will be reviewed by the Guided Pathways Steering Committee.
