1. Welcome and Check In

2. LFM Student Success Team

Patrick Bettencourt reported the team met last week and came up with the next steps idea of coming up with something to keep the momentum going. They are planning on a second meeting with four people from each school (discipline faculty, counselor, success specialist, student representative). They would like to review the plan, talk about objectives, and ask them how they plan to move forward. Shelley Circle suggested having them go out into breakout rooms to develop the meet and greet for spring. They will be meeting in the next two weeks to come up with the agenda.

3. LFM Data Team

Christian Million and Andrew Kranzman reported they are meeting today at noon to keep working on their project, which will be presented at next week's PIT Crew meeting.

4. Paving the Path Sessions:

- a. **Programs in Two Schools (Primary School/Forms/Cohorts/Data)**
- b. **Representation by School (Curriculum Committee, Assessment, Senate, Etc.)**
- c. **Decision Making/Workflow Study Session (What is the most efficient Pathways School?)**
- d. **Support Teams (Entourage/School Board)**
- e. **School Chairs (Start in Senate)**
- f. **Schools and Participatory Governance**

Sessions will be spread throughout the year and directed to specific groups, not campus wide as was in the past. A primary school for the programs needs to be determined. Curtis Martin suggested splitting the sessions between two semesters, briefly touching on it this semester and getting more involved in the next. A discussion ensued on communicating the challenge of divisions organically morphing into schools. Chad Redwing has determined a date to begin this conversation in the Academic Senate.

5. Possible Timings for Paving the Path Sessions and Interested Team Members

The first session will be synchronous and the others either multiple sessions or asynchronous. A counselor, research analyst (data), and evaluator will need to be present. October 19-30 was the time frame suggested for the first session, although two sessions may be needed.
