1) SOAA Update (Belen)

The Scale of Adoption Assessment was presented at academic senate and was well received. They have until this Friday for any edits. The second read will be at the following meeting. There are two additions/suggestions so far.

2) IEPI (Rob)

Moving from Divisions to Schools is in the planning phase. One question is how to connect Starfish to Ad Astra. They are hoping to have marketing materials advertising the schools for the fall. The possible process for renaming schools was discussed.

3) Arrow/Newsletter (Hans)

The webpage containing the newsletter was reviewed. The revised arrow through 2023 is also on the site. Attendees were invited to email Hans with any questions. Larger posters of the newsletter will be printed and distributed throughout the campuses.

4) Review CPL courses: next steps (Tina)

Tina shared a CPL Inventory Review which showed the different ways faculty will accept credit. Discussion continued on how to discuss with faculty. Those with experience should not start at the bottom, they should move to the next level.

5) Next Steps for Contextualized Teaching and Learning (Belen)

This topic was the focus of one of the previous LFM teams and it is addressed in our SOAA. Piloting some schools (College Skills, specifically) needs to begin. Tina and Belen have been working with Matthew to assign two schools this summer, but more is needed.

6) Start Smart update (Angelica or Tina)

They are currently working on selecting the dates to host Start Smart which will occur one week a month from April through August. April's event will be virtual and will focus on students enrolling in summer courses. Following this event, they will host a variety in person. Incentivization for faculty is needed. Especially, if they participate during the summer.

a) Recruit faculty to attend Start Smart

Dates are needed to recruit faculty. They have the weeks, dates and times in mind. Additional feedback is needed before bringing them forward. They will be available soon to share with the success team and marketing.
