1. Welcome and Introductions

Vice President of Student Services, Dr. Andrea Wilson, was introduced. A brief summary of the charge and history of the PIT Crew was given. Members were notified that the November meetings will be on the second and fourth Thursday of the month due to the holidays.

2. CPL (Credit for Prior Learning) Update

a. What is CPL

The CPL Workshop (Part 2): Beginning to Facilitate the Conversation presentation was shared and its contents reviewed. Members were informed that a discipline faculty point person within each area will serve as the go-to person as their CPL courses are being developed. In addition, a counseling point person will be available for consultation within each school and the evaluations team will assist as needed.

Members discussed the different methods to assess CPL and ways to market it to students, campus programs, and the community at large. It was determined that an application grading rubric, a denied application review process, and an appeals process needs to be developed and/or updated.

The group was invited to contact the Planning, Research, Innovation, and Institutional Effectiveness team for any internal or external data needs related to assessments, courses, or programs. Members were also invited to send questions to either Belen, Andrew, or Tina so that they may be compiled as part of our data gathering (Q&A).

The possibility of hiring a CPL Coordinator is being looked into. The Leading From the Middle (LFM) team will pick up the CPL project and work with the coordinator to carry it forward.

MJC is working with Visual Point Design House to update the website and make it more student friendly. The estimated date of completion is December 2022.

b. July and August Workshops

A brief overview of the activities held in August with discipline faculty members was shared.

c. Fall Deliverables

Faculty members will identify CPL courses within their discipline.

d. CPL Rollout

During the spring semester, faculty will build the assessments for each course. Palomar College, who we are working with, stated it takes approximately one semester to build the assessments.

2. SSIPP Reflection Exercise (Part 1)

a. What is SSIPP?

SSIPP stands for Strategic, Sustained, Integrated, Proactive, and Personalized. The exercise will be used to reflect and gather information to showcase Guided Pathways on the website. Members were invited to review the questions prior to discussion at the next PIT Crew meeting.
