Pathways to Success

Modesto Junior College (MJC) recognizes that students with disabilities have the right to equal opportunity for education and that pursuing this right may present unique needs that must be accommodated. Meeting these needs is the purpose of the Disability Services Program.

Who Qualifies

The Disability Services Program is a system of supportive services and classes for students who qualify based on one or more of the following categories:

- ✧ Acquired Brain Injury
- ✧ Communication Disabled; including deaf, hard of hearing and speech impaired
- ✧ Learning Disabled with significant basic skill difficulties that need remediation and/or special accommodations
- ✧ Physically Disabled; including blind and partially sighted
- ✧ Psychological Disabilities
- ✧ Other Disabilities - including persons with attention deficit disorders, heart conditions, epilepsy and other conditions due to chronic or acute health problems.

To receive services, a student must consult with the appropriate specialist to establish eligibility for the program.
