If you have satisfied one of the following options, you will be eligible to directly enroll in English courses without taking the MJC placement test. If you have already taken the MJC placement test, you can still be eligible for approval as long as you haven't already started the English sequence. You must be a high school senior OR have already graduated from high school within the last 10 years to be eligible.

Please complete this form and attach supporting documents. (i.e high school transcripts, test scores) that indicate you have satisfied one of the items below:

Option #1 High School GPA:

- High school cumulative GPA of 2.6 or better makes you eligible for English 101 (this applies to both high school seniors and graduates).
- High school seniors who have a cumulative GPA of 2.3 or better are eligible for English 50.
- High school graduates who have a cumulative GPA of 2.2 or better AND have successfully completed 12th grade English, (Grade = C or better), are eligible for English 50.

Note: Acceptable English courses may include CP English, AP English, IB English, Honors English, or ERWC.

Option # 2 Satisfaction of one or more other Multiple Measures: (You will be eligible to enroll in English 101).

- EAP score of "Exempt" or "Ready" for college-level English courses.
- EAP score of "Conditionally ready" or "Conditional" for college-level English courses **AND** successful completion of the Expository Reading and Writing Course (ERWC), AP English, IB English or an English course approved for extra honors weight on the University of California "A-G" Doorways course list.
- SAT score of 500 or above on the Critical Reading section (test dates prior March 2016).
- SAT score of 550 on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing Section (test dates March 2016 and after).
- Score of 22 or above on ACT English Test.
- Score of 5 or above on IB Language A HL/Language & Literature.
- CLEP score of 50 or above on College Composition.
- EPT score of 147 or higher.

Please note: If you received a score of 3 or above on either Language & Composition or Composition & Literature AP Exams, you are eligible to enroll in any course with prerequisite of ENGL 101 and do not need to complete this form. Contact our office for more information.
