1. Date

The African American Education Conference will take place on Saturday, February 25, 2017. It was suggested that the conference be held annually on the last Saturday of February so that it becomes a campus and community expectation.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the African American Education Conference is to enrich and empower current and future Modesto Junior College students to be successful in pursuing higher education.

It is the hope that guest speakers and workshops will help facilitate and enrich the student experience in achieving that purpose.

3. Theme

A robust discussion over the different theme ideas occurred. The theme of inclusivity was mentioned several times. The following theme was put forward:

Creating Royalty: Engaging youth cultures: past, present, and future.

4. Logistics

The Campus Life and Student Learning staff will coordinate the check in process and the coordination of volunteers to assist with that process.

The MSR and ten classrooms have been reserved for Saturday, February 25, 2017.

A request for marketing materials has been submitted and, when a proof is available, it will be presented to the committee for approval.

We will need to discuss the details of the budget. The total budget is \$6,000 (\$3,000 from Office of Student Equity and \$3,000 from ASMJC). There will be facilities costs associated with the use of the building that is estimated at \$1,000.

5. Keynote Speaker

A variety of different speakers were suggested. It was recommended that Eric Ivory pursue the availability and willingness of Chris Chatmon from Kings of Oakland. No promises will be made until full cost is understood, approved, and budgeted for. Eric will follow up at next meeting.

The committee agreed with no objections.

6. Presentation Topics

The committee discussed several workshop presenters. Lonita Cordova indicated she may be able to secure Prop 63 funds. The committee asked her to move forward with doing so.
