X. ASMJC Shared Governance Council/Committees:

A. YCCD Board Meetings-Harloveleen Hundal & Ninebra Mansour

- ASMJC President stated that the meeting is ones a month and gave the information on the last Senate meeting. Student Trustee Mansour gave her report, she talked about the Board Finance, which meet on September 4th 2018, talked about the 2018-2019 Final Budget, Chancellor thanks students and faculty for being present and wanted to let the faculty know that the District appreciate their work, Discussed the Policy 4-807 for 2nd reading, Approve the MOU and the 2nd reading of the 48067-6400-6850-7125-7310-7330-7336- 78059, adopted the 2018-2019 Special Priority and stated that will be meeting next Wednesday at Columbia College with ASMJC President Hundal.

B. Academic Senate-Alexis Zaragoza

- Vice President Zaragoza stated that the Resolution was approve and that starting next semester on Spring 2019 all teachers are required to put student rights in the syllabus, the Umoja Program wants teachers to participate more and join the training, and talked about a 6-unit Math class that will covers all Math classes under 100.

C. Accreditation Council-Kevyn Canaveral
